



The Gananoque Curling Club is accepting applications for the position of full time/part time Ice Technician for the 2024/2025 season and beyond. This is a seasonal contract position starting in the fall of 2024 through April 2025.

Reporting to the General Manager, the Ice Technician will be responsible for the overall maintenance and operations of the ice operations and ensuring the high standard of playing conditions.

The Gananoque Curling Club is a small, friendly four sheet club that runs with volunteer assistance. The successful applicant needs to be self motivated, energetic and willing to work flexible hours.

Job Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Start up and shut down of the ice plant, including working with an outside refrigeration contractor.
- Coordinating ice installation, ice painting and lines with the assistance of volunteers in accordance with Curling Canada specifications.
- Prepare and maintain the ice surface for league play, bonspiels and other scheduled events as required.
- Ensure ice maintenance equipment is operated efficiently, safely and serviced as required.
- Available to respond to ice plant alarms.
- Perform major mid-season ice maintenance during the Christmas break.
- Coordinate volunteers to assist the Ice Technician as required. ● Spring ice removal.

Qualifications:

Level 1 Ice Technician or higher is preferred. Other experienced candidates will be considered providing they have a willingness to obtain Ontario Curling Association certification.
